Our Club's Inspiration

Teenagers who grew up in California, Ada Praun-Petrovic and Ayla Apsey witnessed firsthand the steadily worsening effects of climate change. From annoying but tolerable heat waves to fires that spread across the entire state and consumed their friends' and families' homes, a threat that many wrote off as a distant possibility became a terrifying reality. In 2020, after months of anxious nightmares, weighing fears, and a growing dread of an uncertain future, Ada and Ayla decided to take action and push for significant change to ensure their own generation's right to live in a clean, nonhazardous world.
